ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. QIU FOUNDATION & DIPLOMA SCHOLARSHIP

The requirements for the **QIU Foundation & Diploma Programme Scholarship** are as stated below:-

Scholarship (%) on Tuition Fee for Foundation Programmes	
50%	100%
3As – 5As in SPM / O Levels	6As and above in SPM / O Levels

- The scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for the **Foundation in Arts, Foundation in Science and Foundation in Business programmes**.
- Applicants are required to enrol in any of the degree programmes at QIU upon completion of the foundation programme.
- Applicants must ensure the degree programme of choice is available at QIU.
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.
- Applicants are required to pay a sum of RM2,000 in deposit which shall be utilised as Basic Fees when the applicant registers for the degree programme. Any differences will be either be paid by the recipient or refunded to the recipient depending on the amount required for utilisation, if any.

- The scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for a **Diploma programme** at QIU.
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.

2. QIU DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP

The minimum requirements for the **QIU Degree Scholarship** are as stated below:-

Scholarship (%) on Tuition Fee for Degree Programmes	
25%	50%
Minimum CGPA 3.0	Minimum CGPA 3.25

- The scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for **all degree programmes, EXCEPT the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) and Bachelor of Pharmacy (Hons) programmes**.
- The scholarship is offered on merit basis to students who have completed the QIU Foundation and QIU Diploma programmes only.
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.

3. QIU ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The minimum requirements for the **QIU Engineering Scholarship** are as stated below:-

50 % Scholarship on Tuition Fee for Degree Programmes		
STPM / MATRICULATION / DIPLOMA / QIU DIPLOMA / QIU FOUNDATION	UEC	A-LEVELS
Minimum CGPA 3.25	Minimum 5Bs including in Mathematics & Physics	Minimum BBB including in Mathematics & Physics

- The scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for the **Bachelor of Mechatronics Engineering with Honours and Bachelor of Electronics Engineering (Communication) with Honours programmes only.**
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.

4. QIU SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP

The minimum requirements for the **QIU Sports Scholarship** are as stated below:-

Sports Scholarship (%) on Tuition Fee for Foundation & Diploma Programmes	
50%	100%
State Player	National Player

- The scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for **any Foundation or Diploma programme.**
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.
- The applicant must fulfill the minimum entry requirements for the foundation or diploma programme of choice.
- The student has to attend an interview to be eligible for the scholarship.

5. QIU UEC SCHOLARSHIP

The minimum requirements for the **QIU UEC Scholarship** are as stated below:-

Scholarship (%) on Tuition Fee		
25%	50%	100%
Minimum 3As in UEC	Minimum 5As in UEC	Minimum 8As in UEC

- The scholarship is applicable to the tuition fee for **all degree programmes EXCEPT the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) and Bachelor of Pharmacy (Hons) programmes.**
- The scholarship is offered on merit basis to students who have completed the UEC (Unified Examinations Certificate) only.
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.
- The student has to attend an interview to be eligible for the scholarship.

6. QIU PHARMACYSCHOLARSHIP

The minimum requirements for the **QIU Pharmacy Scholarship** are as stated below:-

Up to 20% Scholarship on Tuition Fee			
STPM	A Levels	Foundation / Matriculation	Diploma (in related field)
Minimum CGPA 3.00	Minimum BBB or ABC	Minimum CGPA 3.00	Minimum CGPA 3.00

- The merit scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for the **Bachelor of Pharmacy (Hons) only**.
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.
- The student has to attend an interview to be eligible for the scholarship.

EXTERNAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. MADAM PATHMAVATHI SCHOLARSHIP & MR KUMARAKULASINGAM SCHOLARSHIP

The minimum requirements for the Madam Pathmavathi Scholarship and Mr Kumarakulasingam Scholarship are as stated below:-

- The Madam Pathmavathi Scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for the **Bachelor in Early Childhood Education (Hons)** and **Bachelor of Special Needs Education (Hons)** programmes.
- The Mr Kumarakulasingam Scholarship is applicable to the tuition fees for the **Bachelor of Mass Communication (Hons) Journalism, Bachelor of Mass Communication (Hons) Advertising and Bachelor of Corporate Communication (Hons)** programmes.
- The applicants must have obtained a distinction in English (at SPM / O-Levels examination)
- All other costs/payment such as basic fees, hostel fees and transportation must be paid by the student.
- The student has to attend an interview to be eligible for the scholarship.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.0 Applicants eligible to apply for the scholarship awards must be currently enrolled as a full time student at Quest International University Perak ("QIU").
- 2.0 The scholarship is neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash.
- 3.0 The recipients of scholarships (**except** the QIU Sports Scholarship) must maintain a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 every semester. Meanwhile, the recipients of the QIU Sports Scholarship scholarship must maintain a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 every semester. Failure to attain or maintain the required GPA would result in a review of the Scholarship Award and upon review the Scholarship may be withdrawn at QIU's discretion.
- 4.0 All costs related to industrial visits or study trips shall be borne by the students.
- 5.0 All applicants will be evaluated and shortlisted by the Financial Aid Committee of QIU. The Committee reserves the right to change the criteria from time to time.
- 6.0 The recipient of a scholarship must not be in receipt of any other scholarship or award of any nature from any other educational institution or any other Organisation / Foundation/ Government institution unless such scholarship does not conflict in any way with the terms and conditions of this scholarship award by QIU.
- 7.0 The recipient shall at all times abide by the rules and regulations of QIU, which inter alia, are as described below:-
 - 7.1 To give full attention to the course, attend all lectures, practical work and carry out all duties as assigned by QIU;
 - 7.2 To abide by all the regulations of QIU including the Code of Conduct for students, where applicable, and to participate in its training activities whenever required.
- 8.0 The scholarship will be withdrawn forthwith in the event of default or breach by the recipient of any or all of the following sub-clauses;
 - 8.1 If the recipient abandons the course of study, for which the scholarship was awarded to him/her before the stipulated time with or without written consent from QIU;
 - 8.2 If the recipient is found to be a holder of another scholarship or award of any nature as prescribed in clause 6.0 above;
 - 8.3 If the recipient shall at any time during the study period be found guilty of misconduct as prescribed in QIU's Student Hand Book or Hostel Regulations;
 - 8.4 If the recipient has given false or misleading information in the Application Form to QIU in the course of applying for the Scholarship;
 - 8.5 In the event of a "force majeure" where either QIU or the recipient is unable to proceed with the scholarship or terms and conditions as stated herein.
- 9.0 In the event of any breach, as outlined in Clause 7 and 8 above, with the exception of an event of "force majeure" as stated in clause 8.5 above, the Scholarship will be withdrawn and no payments shall be made to the recipient of the scholarship for any unutilized portion of the Tuition or other Fees.
- 10.0 It is compulsory for the recipient to attend the scholarship presentation ceremony (if any) to receive the scholarship. The recipient shall also agree to have his/her name, photo and other particulars published in the event QIU requires such information to be published in the media for promotional purposes. The recipient shall also give his/her consent to QIU to promote its activities for any purpose using the recipient as its subject matter as and when required. Scholarship recipients must act as Ambassadors of QIU at all time and uphold its good name. The recipient is required to assist or participate in the university activities or events whenever it is necessary (a minimum of 15 hours per semester)
- 11.0 QIU reserves the right to vary, amend or alter these Guidelines for the offer of Scholarship as and when required and deemed fit without prior notice.
